What do you want to be in the future? There are many kinds of jobs in the world, and ABC news says there are 18,725 kinds of jobs in Japan. Some of them are very unique.

In some jobs, people depend on their senses to do their work. For example, musicians use their sense of hearing. Chefs use their sense of taste. Some people use the sense of smell when they work. We can check smell levels with some machines, but they just show the levels in numbers. So, using a human nose is important to check how people feel about the smell. For example, companies that sell products that have a smell need to check how people feel about their products. Also, the smell of the air which comes out of factories sometimes causes problems. If the air smells bad, it will cause troubles with people living around the factory. So, it should be checked. In some countries, you need a license to work in jobs that include checking various smells.

Some other jobs need licenses, too. Have you ever heard about a license for preparing *pufferfish? Some parts of pufferfish have strong poison. We have to cut out those parts and throw them away, but it is difficult. Actually, in the Edo period, many people were killed by the poison and they were not allowed to eat the fish. Today, we can eat pufferfish meat prepared by chefs with a special license.

Some jobs have existed for a long time. However, some other unique jobs have started recently. Those jobs are based on technology. *Drone pilots are one of them. Drones can fly high, so they are used for purposes such as checking tall buildings and taking pictures from the sky. Also, some companies try to use them to deliver items. They are trying to fly drones to villages in the mountains and to islands far away. Jobs about computer games are some of the newest jobs, too. Game engineer is now a popular job, and being a professional computer game player is also getting popular today. Players play against each other in video games, and that is called "e-sports." There are tournaments for e-sports. If you win a tournament, you have the chance to win a large amount of money!

Those jobs are just a few examples of unique jobs. How about finding others and learning about them? It may give you more choices for your future.


