Quick Chicken Soup

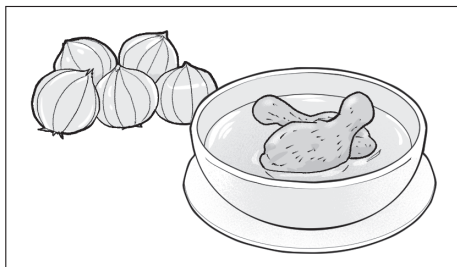

We have four kinds of tastes below.



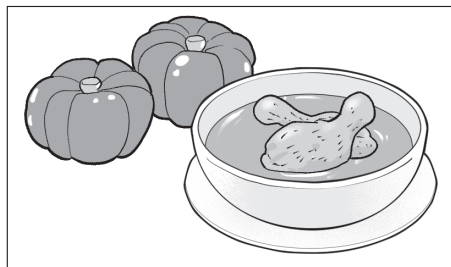
Onion

We use a lot of fresh onions to make this soup. With fresh fish from the sea, the taste becomes rich.



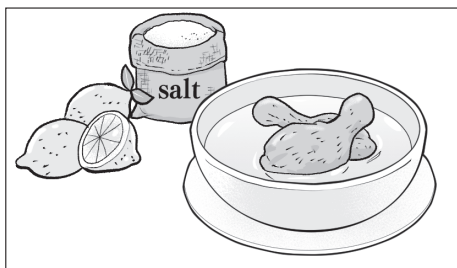
Pumpkin

On a cold day, you should have this soup. It makes you feel warm quickly. Onions and milk add a good taste to the soup.



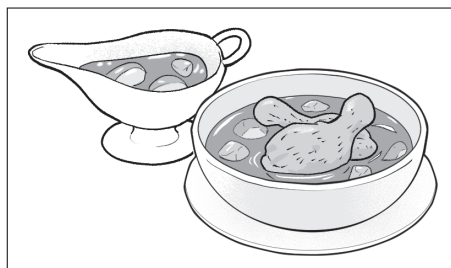
Salt & Lemon

2. When the chicken is boiled enough, add one pack of soup.
3. Boil for about 3 minutes.

In nature, many animals have hard lives. There are many enemies that want to eat them. So, animals have developed many ways to protect their lives.

Maybe you have seen some insects that look like a leaf or a part of a tree. They have the same colors as leaves and trees, so their enemies can't find them easily. Some kinds of birds and their eggs try to survive in the same way. There are some animals that can change their body colors, too. For example, *octopuses can change their body color to the place they are staying at. If these animals don't move, it is very difficult to find them. That is good because the animals don't need a lot of energy to move quickly or fight against their enemies.

On the other hand, some animals use a very simple *method; they run fast. Let's look at rabbits. Rabbits have very strong legs, and they are good at running fast. Some types of rabbits live in wide places like fields. There are not so many things there. So, rabbits can see their enemies easily and start running before the enemies come. However, that means the enemies can also find rabbits easily. Rabbits have to be always able to run. So, rabbit babies open their eyes, stand up, and start to practice running soon after they are born.

Some animals protect their lives by having *poison. One of the most famous animals with poison is the snake. It bites enemies and sends poison into its enemies' bodies. The *skunk is another example. You know it *sprays something with a bad smell at its enemies. It is very harmful. It hurts the enemies' eyes and noses. Having poison sounds powerful, but a lot of energy is needed to make poison in the body. So, animals with poison usually show their *weapons and bright body colors to their enemies first. They hope their enemies will notice they are dangerous and go away.

Animals have many ways to survive in nature. However, their enemies also need to catch other animals to survive. Lions run fast, and wolves have a good *sense of smell. Tigers can get close to other animals because their body colors hide them in the woods. Snakes use their poison when they try to catch smaller animals. In nature, to stop developing means to give up living.
